# 2016 Golf Club Memberships

## Full Club Membership

Golf Club Memberships run concurrent from January 1st to December 31st. Club dues are payable monthly or in-full upon joining and include all of the perks listed to the right. Club members play golf for a daily fee of \$20 for 18 holes or \$10 for 9 holes. **Enjoy waived daily fees and unlimited play by adding an optional trail plan to your club membership.** This option also permits a member-owned cart for year-round use on the golf course. All optional trail plans are payable monthly or in-full upon joining.

## Senior Club Membership

Senior membership opportunities are designed for individual golfers age 62 and older and feature the same perks as full club membership with golfing privileges limited to weekdays only (*Monday through Thursday*). Weekend rounds (*anytime Friday, Saturday or Sunday*) will be automatically priced at public golf rates. Senior club dues and optional trail plans are payable monthly or in-full upon joining.

## Executive Club Membership

Executive membership opportunities are designed for individual golfers age 39 and younger and feature the same perks as full club membership with golfing privileges limited to anytime Friday through Sunday and weekday afternoons (only after 12PM). Weekday rounds before 12PM will be automatically priced at public rates. Executive club dues and optional trail plans are payable monthly or in-full upon joining.

## Student Club Membership

Student membership opportunities are designed for individual golfers ages 16 to 22 and feature the same perks as full club membership with golfing privileges limited to after 12PM every day of the week. Rounds played any day of the week before 12PM will be automatically priced at public golf rates. Student club dues and optional trail plans are payable monthly or in-full upon joining.

## Junior Club Membership

Junior membership opportunities are designed for individual golfers age 15 and under and feature the same perks as full club membership with golfing privileges limited to after 2PM every day of the week. Weekend rounds and weekday rounds before 2PM will be automatically priced at public golf rates. Junior club dues and optional trail plans are payable monthly or in-full upon joining.

## Business Club Membership

Business memberships entitle up to five cardholders to full golf club perks without dues or daily fees. Every service is available for entertaining clients, relaxing and enjoying quality time at the golf course and resort. Individual rounds with golf cart are pre-purchased in bundles of thirty (\$42.50/each), sixty (\$40.00/each) or ninety (\$37.50/each). Nine holes will be counted as half of one round. Business memberships are paid in-full upon joining with a business check or company credit card. *Any unused rounds expire one year from purchase date.*

# 2016 Resort Membership / Recreational Passes

## Full Resort Membership

Full resort membership runs from January 1st until December 31st and are payable monthly or up-front. Resort memberships provide unlimited use of swimming and tennis amenities with waived payment of daily fees. Also includes unlimited guest privileges, preferred member pricing resort-wide (20% off select merchandise, food and beverage, guest suites and special event tickets/rentals), Weekly Resort Raffle and Member Loyalty Rewards Program.

### Pay Up Front, Save A Month

Sign up for a full resort membership in 2016 and pay your annual dues in-full by 1/10/16 for one month free of charge. Monthly amount is subtracted from the total up-front payment.

## Recreational Passes

Available as a basic alternative to club and resort memberships, our recreational passes provide passholder(s) with use of any individual amenities chosen by waiving payment of daily public fees. Recreational passes do not entitle a passholder to perks of membership and must be paid up-front.

### Driving Range Pass 200 Tokens: \$600

Entitles pass holder to 200 small driving range buckets without payment of daily public fees.

### Tennis Court Pass Single: \$325 Couple: \$450 Family: \$575

Entitles pass holder(s) to unlimited use of tennis facilities without payment of daily public fees.

### Swimming Pool Pass Single: \$325 Couple: \$450 Family: \$575

Entitles pass holder(s) to unlimited use of pool facilities without payment of daily public fees.

## 2016 MEMBERSHIP TERMS & CONDITIONS

**ADMINISTRATION:** All personal records and account information are held confidentially for club-use only. Members are required to give written notice of change in mailing or e-mail address to which communications should be directed. Any new Full Club, Executive, Senior or Student memberships are subject to a \$500.00 Commitment Fee upon joining. Initiation fees will be waived for any new member (Full, Senior, Executive or Student) that joins the Beau Rivage Golf Club on or before January 10, 2016. All memberships will be automatically renewed one year after the date of joining unless written notification to management is provided at least 30 days in advance.

**CART OPERATION:** The operator of any cart used for course play must have a valid driver's license and is required to sign the Starter's Log prior to teeing off. At Beau Rivage, all members are required to play using the 90° Rule at all times unless otherwise specified by the Golf Shop (Cart Path Only on specific holes due to rain, maintenance projects, etc.). Ride the path until reaching your next shot, then drive in a straight line directly to your ball. Exit fairways on the same path that you entered. Beau Rivage requires that all players stay away from bare spots in the turf and keep out of the woods. Carts should always remain on the path near all tee boxes and putting surfaces at all times. All Par 3 Holes (#4, #5, #12 and #15) are Cart Path Only. Any damages inflicted on a cart as a result of member misuse may result in repair fees or, depending on circumstances of the damage (and at the sole discretion of management), loss of membership good-standing. Beau Rivage recognizes that some players have limitations that make it difficult to walk long distances during a round. Customized Member Handicap Placards and Handicap Cart Flags are offered for those who provide a valid doctor's note.

**COURSE ETIQUETTE:** The game of golf relies on the integrity of the individual player to show consideration for others and to abide by the rules. Members are required to conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times. Club Members must always be aware of others in their group, others on the course and themselves and should never take any action that could endanger anyone. Members should also do anything possible to leave the course the way it was found by filling divots, raking sand traps and repairing ball marks on putting surfaces. USGA Rules apply at all times unless otherwise stated. Appropriate course attire consists of a collared/golf shirt and no denim. To help preserve the quality of course conditions, only soft-spikes or soft-sole shoes should be worn during play. Personal coolers and glass bottles specifically are not permitted on the golf course or Beau Rivage grounds at any time. **Groups of five or more players are not permitted to play on the golf course at any time.** For safety purposes, no activity other than golf is permitted on the golf course. Golf staff have full authority to enforce all rules, monitor pace of play and may do whatever is deemed necessary to alleviate any issues that may occur on golf course property. Please contact the Golf Shop directly at (910) 392-9021 should you see any suspicious activities occurring on golf course property.

**GOLF HANDICAP:** The purpose of a Handicap System is to make the game of golf more enjoyable for golfers by providing a means of measuring one's performance and progress by establishing a Handicap Index. This index enables golfers of differing abilities to compete on an equitable basis. To play in any competitive member golf events at Beau Rivage, it is essential that each player conform to the responsibilities outlined in the Beau Rivage Golf Club Handicap Policy.

**GOLF OUTINGS:** Beau Rivage hosts a wide variety of golf outings and events throughout the year and reserves the right to charge additional fees (eg. Tournament, Shotgun Fees) on top of existing member golf fees or annual trail plans. A full list of scheduled 2016 golf events can be found online at [www.beaurivagegolf.com](http://www.beaurivagegolf.com).

**GOOD STANDING:** To maintain good-standing, a primary member is required to keep their account current and adhere to all membership terms and conditions. Primary members, account dependents and their guests are required to conduct themselves in a respectful manner while using the facilities. Any member that infringes upon any term or guidelines will at first offense be given a verbal warning, at second offense be given a written notice of infringement and at third offense be subject to suspension (non-refundable) of membership and all of the entitlements. At fourth offense, the member will be subject to a non-refundable forfeiture of membership. Beau Rivage reserves the right to suspend or terminate any club membership that, in its discretion, fails to meet these criteria.

**HOURS OF OPERATION:** The golf course and resort facilities are available for use 364 days out of the year (closed on Christmas Day only) during established business hours that are posted throughout the clubhouse and online at [beaurivagegolf.com](http://beaurivagegolf.com). Beau Rivage reserves the right to close the course, facilities or portions of either during established hours for scheduled maintenance, repairs, outings or private functions.

**LOYALTY REWARDS:** Golf club and resort members are automatically set-up to enjoy Beau Rivage's Member Loyalty Rewards Program. Rather than enforcing a monthly spending minimum, this program is designed to reward member support by providing spending incentives. In 2016, club and resort members will receive one (1) Loyalty Point per \$1.00 spent at Beau Rivage on food and beverage and select merchandise. Every 500 points earned may be redeemed for a \$25 BR Gift Card valid on any purchases around the resort. Referring a new club member to join at Beau Rivage will create extra rewards. Any current member that refers a new Golf Club membership (Full, Senior, Executive, Student, Junior) is rewarded with double loyalty points throughout the year — two (2) points earned per \$1.00 spent. Referrals must provide the current member's account number on their application to qualify.

**MEMBERSHIP CARDS:** Each primary member, spouse and account dependent is required to have a picture identification taken for their membership card. Embedded with an account number, member cards are used to process applicable discounts for preferred pricing, accumulate loyalty points on sales and track spending when used at clubhouse sales registers. Membership cards may also be used for charging payments to your club account (credit card on-file required). This service is offered at no charge and can be set-up or cancelled at any time. Members are required to carry their cards at all times while using the facilities and display them to the staff any time a transaction is made. Cards may only be used by the person to whom they are issued. In the event that a card is misplaced, a replacement may be provided for a \$10.00 fee. All membership cards expire on January 1, 2017.

**MEDICAL LEAVE:** Any excused Medical Absence (sixty days or more) of a Club Member will be adjusted or credited toward the future by Beau Rivage management staff.

**PACE OF PLAY:** The USGA estimated time of completion for 18 holes by a foursome is four hours and thirty minutes. Pace of play is monitored by the Golf Shop, Course Starters and Course Ambassadors to ensure an enjoyable golfing experience for all players. Any golfers falling behind pace may be asked (via staff or GPS dashboard messages) to keep up with the group ahead or allow groups to play through. **PAYMENT TERMS:** Any club or resort membership may be paid for in-full upon signing (ask about up-front payment incentives). Monthly terms are reserved for Golf Club (Single, Couple, Family, Senior, Executive, Student, Junior) and Resort memberships only. Dues are payable on the 1st of every calendar month and must be received by the 10th to avoid any late fees (\$25.00). Accounts more than 30 days late without any notification to the club will suffer a loss of good-standing and the primary member will be billed as public for all rounds played and purchases made, including those from the start of the month, until the account becomes current. Once an account loses good-standing, it forfeits any perks due and is deactivated. There is a \$100 account re-activation fee. To free members from the hassle of writing checks, making extra trips to the clubhouse or worrying about late fees, Beau Rivage offers the convenience of automatic monthly payments. When set up, dues are charged on the 1st of each month using a credit card held on file. This free additional service is optional and may be started or cancelled at any time. Any charges to a member account must be signed at the time of sale and will be paid monthly with a credit card on-file. Any member tabs that are left open overnight in The Veranda will automatically be charged to credit card on-file with an 18% gratuity.

**POOL GUIDELINES:** Members are required to display their identification cards to the pool attendant upon entering the swimming facilities. Golf Club and Resort members may receive unlimited daily guest passes to the pool but must accompany guests while using the amenities. Seasonal pass holders may bring guests to the pool for half-off the daily public fee (\$5.00 per person). Children under the age of 14 need to be supervised by an adult at all times. Personal coolers or glass bottles are not permitted inside the pool facilities at any time. **BEAU RIVAGE DOES NOT EMPLOY LIFEGUARDS. MEMBERS AND GUESTS SWIM AT THEIR OWN RISK.**

**PREFERRED PRICING:** Golf Club and Full Resort members are entitled to preferred pricing (20% discount on select merchandise, food and beverage purchases, clubhouse suites, special events tickets and private event rentals). Member discounts are not applicable toward alcohol sales or in combination with any promotional rates. It is important to display membership cards for every transaction to ensure the proper discounts are applied and that member loyalty points are accrued.

**RANGE OPTIONS:** Club members are privy to two different half-price driving range options. Members may purchase tokens for 50% off the public price (\$3 for small bucket, \$5 for large bucket). Club Members may also choose buy a pre-purchased Range Pass for 50% off the public price (\$300.00 for 200 small range buckets).

**TEE TIMES:** Golf club members are reserved the right to book tee times up to four weeks in advance. Tee times may be booked in the Golf Shop, over the phone or online by visiting [www.beaurivagegolf.com/teetimes](http://www.beaurivagegolf.com/teetimes). When reserving tee times, members should provide as much information as possible (names of other players or guests in a group, using a private cart, etc.) to ensure a faster check-in process on the day of play. For the sake of maintaining an enjoyable pace of play for all, each tee time block is limited to no more than four players. Multiple blocks (any group larger than a foursome) may be reserved by a member if that person is making arrangements on behalf of the group. Individual players must confirm their own spots in the group by 12:00 p.m. the day before or they may be released to the public. Members that need to cancel a round must notify the Golf Shop to avoid wasted tee times that may have otherwise been used. All no-shows are recorded throughout the year. Habitual member no-shows may result in a loss of member good-standing.

**TRAIL PLANS:** Annual plans allow members to enjoy unlimited rounds of golf with waived payment of daily fees. They also provide the option of using privately-owned cart on the golf course once it has been fully registered with the club. Any full club member with five consecutive years good-standing that turns 80 years old will be entitled to a free Single Trail Plan for life so long as the membership account remains current and they remain a member in good-standing.
